Behaviour management at Kilmaine is not a prominent issue. We inclusively support all of our children to listen, attend to their learning and to be kind friends. The launch of the Kilmaine Code from September continues to define everyone's expectations for behaviour in our school community and has been a successful way of ensuring continuity across all parts of school life.

One aspect of school behaviour is <u>uniform</u>. We ask that ALL PUPILS wear the correct school uniform each day. Children should not wear make-up or jewellery such as 'dangly earrings' which are unsafe. Shoes should be supportive and black traditional shoes only are acceptable on traditional uniform days. Trainers of any colour are allowed only on days for PE uniform.
